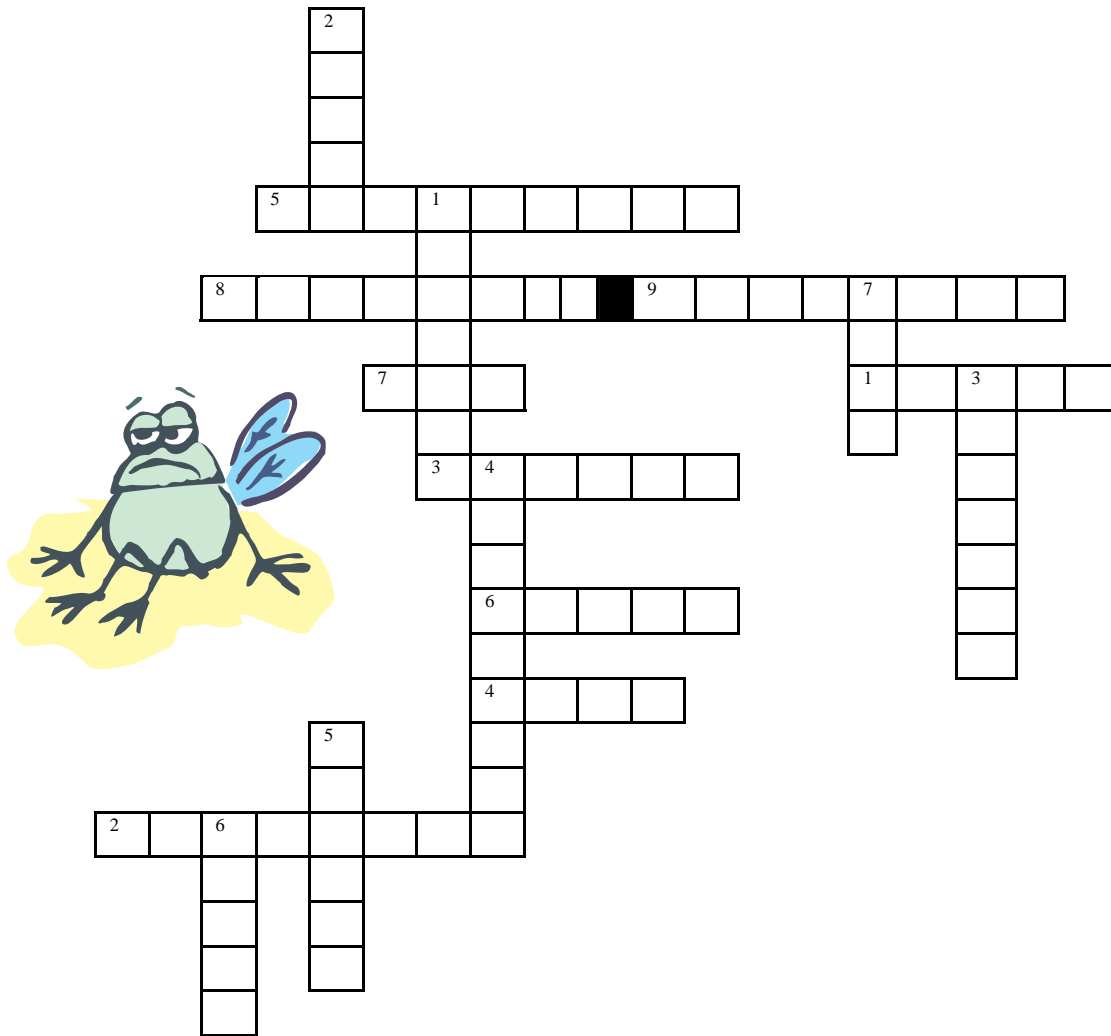




## Hepatitis B and Me Crossword
